County Regulations

THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS RELATE TO COMPETITIONS, INTER-CLUB LEAGUE, AND COUNTY MATCHES.

BOWLS must have a legible stamp dated 1985 or later for Club, County & National competitions until you qualify for the National Finals.

UNIFORM:

Inter-Club League and County Competition Finals

Club registered colours or greys below the waist, Club Shirt above the waist. Flat soled bowling shoes.

County Matches including Midland County games.

Black below the waist, county shirts, flat soled bowls shoes. County cardigans/waistcoats with County Badge can be worn until phased out. County Jacket.

For Atherley Trophy: Any coloured smoothed soled shoes, plain white or registered colour trousers/regulation skirts/cropped trousers or EIBA / Bowls Manufacturer shorts and Indoor County registered shirt • All players should wear the same shirt design. With the exception of registered shirts or trousers no advertising or promotional material may be displayed other than the Bowls Manufacturers' label. Shirts/blouses must have collars and sleeves. White bowls jackets with coloured piping may be worn or registered coloured jacket.

Players may only play for one Club in Inter-Club League and Club Competitions.

Nationals and Club Competitions need not be played from the same Club

At Inter-Club League games stickers should be Club stickers. If there is a clash of colour, the challengers keep their colour, visitors change.
